

Student Early Warning Indicators

Youth Success Teams, including Site Supervisors and Promise Fellows, use student data to determine youth for Focus List eligibility.

The data must include the following Early Warning Indicators (the ABCs):

Showing Impact - Data & Reflections

Promise Fellows support the youth on their Focus Lists with at least 30 minutes of interventions every week. Intervention type and duration are tracked by the Promise Fellow and submitted to the Alliance using an online system called OnCorps.

Intervention data cannot tell the full story of the impact Promise Fellows have on youth served. Each month, Promise Fellows submit short service reflections called Great Stories via OnCorps, including stories about their impact on youth served, current projects, personal development, and feedback for the Alliance. These reflections are an important part of a Promise Fellow's data tracking responsibility. Understanding, sharing, and celebrating these stories is an invaluable part of service and evaluation.
